# EU support to post-floods recovery

**Donors Conference of 16 July: 85 M € pledged for Bosnia and Herzegovina**

**Assistance provided in two packages:**

- 1. EU Flood Recovery Programme (42.24 M €): on-going since 15 August 2014;**
- 2. IPA 2014 Special Measures (appr. 43 M €): planned**

**Additional funding: 20 M € regional programme for river management jointly with Serbia**

**Based on findings of the Recovery Needs Assessment (RNA) for Bosnia and Herzegovina**

# 1. EU Flood Recovery Programme

**Launched in August 2014 to assist local communities in restoring normal living conditions and ensure help reaches the most vulnerable**

## **Specific activities:**



- ✓ **4,000 dwellings for approximately 14,000 people**
- ✓ **90 educational institutions (including pre-school facilities)**
- ✓ **three municipality buildings and four Centres for social welfare**
- ✓ **Four healthcare facilities**
- ✓ **Ten water and sanitation facilities**
- ✓ **100 local roads and bridges**

**Worth 43.52 million € (EU's contribution 42.24 M € IPA funding)**

**Implemented by UNDP**

## 2. IPA 2014 Special Measures

### Ready for implementation in 2015 (appr. 63 million IPA funding):

- ✓ 13.5 M € from IPA National Programme 2014
- ✓ 27.5 M € from the IPA Regional Programme
- ✓ 1,75 M € from IPA National savings
- ✓ Additional 20 M € from IPA Regional for joint regional projects for flood protection and river management with Serbia

### Priorities:

- ✓ Strengthening civil protection capacities for emergency response
- ✓ Supporting civil society efforts for social and economic recovery in flood affected areas
- ✓ Flood protection and river management urgent measures in BiH and regional measures jointly with Serbia
- ✓ SMEs and local development in flood-affected areas
- ✓ Additional housing support
- ✓ Rehabilitation of judicial infrastructure
