Question 1:

For Lot 2 (CISs)

In ANNEX II+III Technical specification there is no mention about TEMPEST Standards (NATO SDIP-27 Standard, NATO AMSG Standard, NATO TEMPEST zoning Standard,) which are usually being asked in this type of project for equipments.

Can you please confirm me, if any (or which exactly) TEMPSET Standards for supply equipments are required?

Answer 1:

No TEMPEST standards are required in the ANNEX II+III because the goal of this tender is to support Bosnia and Herzegovina with a system capable of handling EU classified information up to RESTREINT UE level. At this classification level, according to the current policies and standards, there is no need to apply TEMPEST rules.
